TEAM DIALOGUE



EVERYONE RECEIVES DIALOGUE

- In a section, the director should see the following members each month: the team leaders or the group leaders, each AFIRE coordinator or members of the section work team, and the directors of apostolates within the Federation.
- Each Team Leader sees the members on their teams.

WHAT TEAM DIALOGUE IS NOT

- Team Dialogue is not spiritual direction
- Team Dialogue is not a check list of questions assessing the performance of a team member.

WHAT TEAM DIALOGUE IS

- An opportunity to speak one on one with each member entrusted to your care about their life in Regnum Christi. An opportunity to show how much you value the member
- Questions one might ask?
 - How do you feel the Encounters w/ Christ are going? Do you find them engaging?
 - (If the answer is no ask them what would would help improve their experience?)
 - How is your relationship with the other men/women on the team?
 - How are they living their apostolic life? How is their apostolic work- life balance? Is it too much work, not enough? Do they need a new challenge?
 - Are you able to see your spiritual director on a regular basis? (if not why? Is it them or the Spiritual Director? Are they happy w/ their SD? Do they need a new one? Members do not need to disclose who they see, only that they have access to one as often as they need and it is a good relationship.

A GENTILE REMINDER

It is important to keep in mind that life in Regnum Christi cannot be limited to a series of means, activities or regular meetings. It is above all a loving relationship with Christ in the Church, that imprints on us a particular style of Christian life and urges us to do apostolate according to each person's circumstances and possibilities, using the means that God gives each one.

MEANS TO GROW IN REGNUM CHRISTI

- Team activities, the Encounter with Christ, monthly retreats, Study Circles and annual triduum of renewal or spiritual exercises are all activities in which you encounter the charism in a specific way.
- Although these activities should be a regular part of each member's life. The lifestyle of an RC member will have many fluctuations. It is important that the team leader understands the individual challenges in each member's life and where needed, gently encourages or challenges her members to particpate more consistently.

APOSTOLIC DIALOGUE

- Apostolic Dialogue is a specific form of dialogue.
- It is meant for both accompaniment within the work of apostolate and a means for accountability.
- The nature of the meeting is around the action plan/ program for the apostolate.
- Questions center around the work itself and the person doing the work.
 - How is execution of the plan, any challenges the leader is facing, any ways the Section Leadership can support the work.
 - How's the work life balance of the apostle? Are they tired, burned out or thriving?
