- Current situation: three Lay Consecrated Men (Antonio Maza, Fernando Suarez, Tony MacDonnell)
- Areas of work include: Finance, Human Resources, administration, operations. Campus Ministry, teaching
- All men work at Divine Mercy University and Tony Teaches theology at a Catholic High school
- We are represented on the local Washington RC locality team
- A new Consecrated men's community was founded in Virginia in June 2022
- In March 2023 the Arlington Diocese officially granted us permission as a recognized community
- in November 2018 we became a society of Apostolic Life
- Potential for two more consecrated men to be transferred to Virginia in 2024
- 2010 to 2020 first Consecrated men's only community in the USA started in the Archdiocese of New York

Concerns

- Vocations we are now working with Fr Martin Connor and the vocational committee for the territory
- Seeking 501-C3 nonprofit status in order to build some patrimony
- Aging population (medical, housing and retirement costs)
- Since there are only three of us, it is hard to put much extra energy, time, and money into vocation outreach, delegate duties, local RC duties and then our main apostolates. It's a challenge, but we're doing what we can with the help of the Lord.
