Locality Evangelization Planning Roles

LOCALITY EVANGELIZATION PLANNING TOOL



Locality Plan Sponsor:

Champion of the strategic planning effort, convinced of its value and motivated to engage people in the process; selects and supervises the planning coordinator; mobilizes members to participate. Typically, locality leadership will delegate one of its members to be the locality's spokesperson for the planning effort, often the RC Director.

Planning Coordinator:

Manages and administers locality planning. Works with the locality plan sponsor to outline and guide the process to develop and then monitor implementation of the Locality Evangelization Plan; reports regularly to locality leadership. Depending on the scope of the planning effort, the planning coordinator may assemble a team to help with the process. For smaller localities, the RC Director could potentially serve as the planning coordinator. This person would have good organizational, planning and people skills.

Planning Session Facilitator:

A professional or experienced planning facilitator; consults with the planning coordinator providing input on the planning approach; helps design the planning workshop; facilitates the planning workshop. A facilitator needs to be unbiased, clear on the objectives of the planning session, and skilled at managing group dynamics.

Territorial Planning Support Team:

Provides training and support to planning coordinators; recommends facilitators; develops and offers tools and resources to support locality planning; maintains a network of planning coordinators to identify and shares best practices.

Goal Owner:

Responsible for achieving one or more locality plan goals as set out in the locality evangelization plan; develops and executes on the action plan and budget; reports regularly to the planning coordinator on progress; collaborates with others in the locality as needed.
